



5. The caller then verifies the *Bingo!*
6. If you've used edible place markers, feel free to eat them at the end of your game!

Alternate option:

- To reuse bingo cards, place them in plastic sheet protectors and use dry-erase markers to mark each word. Cards may also be laminated.

Here are a few ideas to generate discussion as you enjoy your “Preach the Gospel Bingo” game:

- Read aloud [Matthew 28:18-20](#), [Mark 16:15](#) and [Luke 24:46-47](#), comparing and contrasting each passage. What were the disciples commanded to do? How? What might this have involved then? What might it involve today?
- Discuss ways we can preach the gospel of the Kingdom in our daily lives (hint: we may not all give expert presentations or be great writers, but we can all set an example).
